CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

The incumbent must:

- Be registered with the South African Revenue Services.
- Have a traceable portfolio of evidence in a form of recommendation letters and contactable references.
- Have experience with funding mechanisms that include but not limited to grants, technical assistance, private-public partnerships.
- Have knowledge of Public Service Act, Treasury Regulations, and other frameworks such as the PPPFMA (Preferential procurement Policy Framework; Public Finance Management Act (PFMA); National Treasury regulations; Promotion of Access to Information Act, Public Service Act, and the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPI).

Qualifying candidates must submit the following documents for consideration:

- Comprehensive CV
- Certified copies of qualifications and Identity Document (not older than 3 months)
