

## STUDENT FINANCIAL AID PAGE

The Department Higher Education, Science and Technology offers bursaries to eligible students through the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS). Students who meet the criteria outlined on DHET Bursary rules and guidelines will be subjected to the availability of funds.

### Who may apply for NSFAS bursary?

- \*Student must be registered with a public TVET college
- \*South African citizen
- \*Students with combined household income must not exceed R350 000 per annum
- \*Students who took a gap year must re-apply for NSFAS

### What are the documents required to apply for NSFAS bursary:

- \*Applicant copy of SA ID document (ID BOOK, CARD OR BIRTH CERTIFICATION IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ID BOOK)
- \* Copy of parent / s or guardian/s and / or your spouses ID (or a death certificate where applicable)
- \* Proof of home address
- \* Copies of your parent/s or guardian/s salary advice, letter of employment, pension advice or SASSA letter.
- \*A completed application form signed by parent/s, guardian/s or spouse.
