## IMPORTANT FACTORS TO NOTE BETWEEN TABLE 1 AND TABLE 2

- Table 1 has 2023 students while Table 2 has 2029 students. This is because six students were paid twice for Semester 1 and Semester 2;
- There is a difference of R1,270,500.00 between Table 1 and Table 2. The difference implies that there are students who do not have Cellbux Accounts registered. The SFA Office will assess who these students are and text messages (sms) will be sent to these students urging them to create Cellbux Accounts.

## IMPORTANT FACTORS TO NOTE BETWEEN MEMORANDUM DATED 13<sup>TH</sup> AND MEMORANDUM DATED 18<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2021

The memorandum issued on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021 confirmed that there were 453 students reflecting as not being paid from Cycle 1. The Student Financial Aid Office will follow up on the status of the 453 students to provide an update to students.

The memorandum issued on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021 stated that the college is expecting 1080 students to be paid on the 15<sup>th</sup> October for Cycle 2.

The Office of Student Financial Aid will follow up on any differences between what was expected and what was paid.

The status of the 93 students disclosed on the 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021 memorandum as having been resolved but will be paid post 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021 will also be followed up with NSFAS.

At time of writing this memorandum, that follow up was not done as SFA is on campus visits.

## CONCLUDING REMARKS

Students with further NSFAS queries are advised that Student Financial Aid Office is visiting campuses this week.

Students are urged to visit the SFA officials and ensure that their queries are brought to the attention of SFA.
