Duties	<p>Rendering a basic PHC service to employees within the CJC College Health Services in the Campus Clinics. 4 Nurses to manage 7 existing campus based Covid-19 clinics for the college, on rotational basis. As some campuses go into recess, nurses may be required to rotate into operating campuses. Test and submit Covid-19 specimen for affected staff and students to laboratories. Comorbidity testing and confirmations for affected staff requesting to work from home. Comorbidity testing and confirmation of affected students requesting special permission to be treated as persons with comorbidities. Advise management of material risk to consider in making decisions related to the health of its staff and students. Processing and assessing applications from persons with comorbidities; advising stay at home provisions owing to comorbidities. Provide comprehensive reports as required. Onsite COVID-19 testing, using our existing clinics. Provide professional assistance and advice during Covid-19 outbreaks. In the case of onsite nurses, the COVID-19 services will be prioritized, followed by general health care where possible, within the allocated working hours. Mentorship/supervision of student nurses, by contracted nurses if and when applicable. Refer patients to PHC institutions for serious health care conditions.</p> <p>Conduct medical surveillance; daily patient management (staff); monitoring of staff with comorbidities, COVID-19 management of staff including screening, testing and contact tracing. Ordering and management of medication. Ensure implementation of Department of Health policies including Batho Pele Principles, Patient's Right's Charter and Occupational Health and Safety Policy. Management of vaccinations against COVID-19, where applicable. Maintaining stock levels of PPE, stationary, equipment and medication. Implementation and monitoring of Health care waste compliance.
